I am very pleased and proud to attach our <u>Ofsted report</u> from the inspection that we had at the end of February. I am delighted but unsurprised that we have been graded Good in all areas.

As a school we have worked incredibly hard to ensure that our students have a great experience whilst attending Chessington School. Whether that be during the 300 minutes of lessons, the daily tutor time, the enrichment activities or the excellent pastoral care that we provide.

The inspection report highlights the following areas key strengths of our school:

- Excellent relationships between students and staff characterise the school
- Broad and ambitious curriculum which goes beyond the National Curriculum
- Highly inclusive of all students; especially those with SEND
- Staff have high expectations of behaviour
- Lessons are rarely disrupted and the school is orderly
- Students feel safe
- Carefully designed personal development programme
- Good preparation for next steps in education and careers
- Staff feel supported and receive high quality training
- Staff have a sharp focus on what is going well and needs to improve

In terms of what we need to improve, the inspectors only found one area for us to focus on which is very rare! Where we have redesigned a couple of subject curriculums to ensure greater depth of understanding, the inspectors are keen that these new curriculums are further embedded. This is something that, as the inspectors highlighted, we are already aware of and working to support the teachers in those areas.
