- Year 11 0855 and lining up in the Sports Centre
- Year 12 and 13 - 8.55am in S2

Online Learning for Year 8 and 9:

- Students online at 8.55am and complete Skodel Check in.
- Periods 1 and 2 Maths
- Periods 3 and 4 Science
- Periods 5 and 6 English
- All work set on Google Classroom
- All students expected to complete all of the work.
- Year 8 and 9 that are invited in or requested will be supervised by our SEN and Pastoral team
