Approaching the on- screen exam

Listen carefully to the invigilator - they will tell you which codes to enter where.

Write all answers in the boxes provided.

You can go back and forward through questions - so if you think of something later on, go back and add it!

At the end do not close anything - wait for instructions from your invigilator

Answering questions

READ the question

Look at the number of marks

What do you need to do?

WRITE the answer

At the end, go back and check you have answered **EVERY** question.

Spelling doesn't matter, as long as it makes sense and can be read!

What's it asking?

Identify / Suggest / Name / State - one word answer / name this thing (1 mark per thing)

Describe - name something, then explain it (2 marks, 1 for name, 1 for explain)

Explain - explain the thing, then say why (it does ... because...) (2 marks)

Match - drag the boxes to line up the right answer (1 mark per answer)

Discuss - long answer wanted! Talk about some pros and cons, say why they are pro/con and give some examples. (10 marks - 5 things, 5 explanations)

**Go and smash it
You've got this!**

**Remember, it might be an obvious/easy
answer.**
